One of the Kenmore guys came over and explained the police boat will come over and tow you away! I think you can get away with a pick up or drop off, we did, but don't leave it there. Just across the way you can use the guest dock at Chandlier's Landing, now without a

reservation. I've been over there and walked it off. We didn't have the Beast with us, but it should work fine. Kenmore was gracious, they said we can use their dock too for a pick up or drop off anytime it's not jammed up with traffic. But, it looks a little high on the west dock for the floats. You'd have to be out on the north dock or on the end near their fuel dock.

Seabee Accidents

I found some interesting reading on AOPA web site. You can pull up accidents by type. There were 25 Seabee accidents over the last 20 years with 3 fatalities. Here are some of the stats. Bottom line is... Know your airplane, know the conditions and don't get distracted from the landing check.

5 water landings with wheels down!

8 had engine failures, at least 3 were due to improper maintenance, some interesting stuff including loose spark plugs.

7 were due to loss of control... some of these were real bone head maneuvers, and make for real interesting reading, things like over gross, out of *CG*, departure stalls,improper prop installed... this guy with the wrong prop couldn't get off a 9000 foot runway after 2 attempts. He got off briefly the third time. Or the one in Monument Valley @ 7600' DA and 30-45 knot winds...

- 1 fuel feed problem
- 1 lost prop
- 1 wrong prop installed

and other acc

- 1 step taxi
- 1 docking (unrated pilot rammed the dock and fell out the right door...Bee sank)
- 1 unknown

<u>Folding or Inflateable Boats</u> I had asked for information on these handy little boats to take along in the Beast. These are the responses I recieved. Thanks guys, I haven't gotten one yet, but I plan to get out more this year and hope to take advantage of one of these...

- 1. Byron Miller writes... Mine is 13'9" long. It is a <u>Metzler brand</u>, <u>Model is Juca</u>. They were bought out and made by Zodiac, which became Sevylor and have a range of sizes from about 7ft up to the big one I have. I have seen these first hand and they are identical to my original Metzeler. which will handle up to 15 hp which I have had on mine. It weighs 69 lbs in rowing mode. Extremely safe and small when rolled up. Even met one maniac in Alaska that was using a 50hp. jet outboard on one just like mine and running rapids with it. The smallest model is Sevytex SVX250, at 8'6". The website is <u>www.sevylor.com</u> These boats are pretty tough and motor nicely. I would imagine a 2-3 hp outboard would be just fine and they are not too heavy. A 2hp Honda pushes my 14' OK if I am not in a hurry.
- 2. Several people suggested...The Fold-a-boat. Sold at Campers World, were they have some other models too.
- 3. Fred Sorenson from Yelm, says... the Luger Boat Company had folding boat kits. Check any of the Popular Mechanics Magazines for the ads in the back. This is the last place I saw them. Folbot Folding Kayaks: Since 1933. Greenland II double, Aleut and Kodiak singles. Sail kits, paddles

Tom Donnelly suggested...You can rent a Feathercraft folding Kayak from a local guy here in Seattle. http://www.foldingkayak.com/ [Lyle@foldingkayak.com] I have a Feathercraft Klondike but have rented the larger K2 Expedition. It comes in two bags and goes together in about 45minutes. Huge volume! If you are not hauling a lot of stuff you may want to consider getting the Klondike w/ the triple opening deck, that way you can accommodate the dog in the center without having to remove the top deck. The Klondike also has the option to operate as an open kayak w/ the cockpit cover removed. Give Lyle a shout, he is a really nice guy.

Henry's Auxilary Wing Tanks
