#### Greetings,

As most of you know there have been some issues that have come up with The Port of Bremerton and Lake Isabel. Since I've blasted you with all that information recently, I won't belabor the whole situation again. However, I will still ask for your help, and provide you with information as it comes available.

Here's a great idea for a rudder lock! I was tired of trying to tie my pedals together and didn't want to carry around some big strap for the rudder. Henry showed me how to use two carriage bolts secured in the lower rudder hinge, so I added a flag used to mark sprinkler system heads.



I drilled a small hole just under the head of the bolt and ran the wire through. It can be fixed to the outside bolt, the inside, or closet to the curve just slides free. After drilling I coated them in the tool handle goop you can buy at the hardware store to coat your tool handles.



The one sliding bolt allow some flexibility so you can get it to slide in. Once installed, let the wind blow ... it won't move.
