IDENTIFICATION PLATES

Some of the first airplanes delivered had paper identification labels located inside the bow door, and a few cases paper instruction plates were installed on the instrument panel due to a shortage of etched metal plates at the time of delivery. Since the etched plates are now available, we are forwarding these to you for installation in place of the paper ones. These plates may be installed with four rivets or self-tapping screws.

Enclosed are the metal plates stamped with the correct serial number for the affected airplanes in your territory.
