WARRANTY

Under the existing warranty policy, Republic cannot reimburse for labor costs, but will replace any part found unsatisfactory due to materials or workmanship. Unsatisfactory parts may be returned to the factory for warranty consideration, transportation prepaid, upon permission of Republic. Action should be taken promptly since it will permit an early factor inspection of the part for purposes of credit consideration, and for the investigation of the material and workmanship. Parts so returned must be properly tagged with the airplane serial number and date to permit identification and to establish an offsetting credit against the invoice for any replacement part. All replacement parts will be invoiced to the Distributor for accounting purposes until credit is assured.

All contact with the factory must be through the Distributor-Dealer network.

The Republic Standard Warranty is printed herewith for your information. Each airplane upon delivery carries a copy of the warranty; the Dealer's Sales Agreement carries a statement of warranty, as does each Distributor's Terms of Purchase. The warranty is similar to engine, propeller, and accessory warranties and to those of other aircraft manufacturers.

REPUBLIC STANDARD WARRANTY

“Republic warrants new Republic products against defects in material or workmanship under normal use but Republic’s obligation, under this warranty, is specifically limited to making good at its factory any part which shall within 90 days after delivery thereof to Distributor be returned to Republic, with its permission, transportation charges prepaid, and which upon examination by Republic, is determined to be defective.”

“This warranty shall not apply to any Republic product which has been repaired or altered outside Republic’s factory in any way so as to affect, in Republic’s judgement, its stability or reliability or which has been subjected to misuse, negligence, improper maintenance or accident, or which has been loaded beyond its factory rated load capacity.”

“Republic makes no warranty with respect to equipment which it does not itself build or manufacture inasmuch as such equipment is usually guaranteed by the respective manufacturers thereof.”

“The foregoing is the exclusive warranty made by Republic. There are no other warranties, express or implied in fact or in law, made by Republic.”
